



Georgia Lost Vehicle Title Replacement

If your vehicle title is lost, stolen, or damaged, you can apply for a duplicate title through the Georgia Department of Revenue — Motor Vehicle Division. Use this checklist to prepare your application.

QUICK ANSWER

To replace a lost Georgia vehicle title, visit your county tag office and request the duplicate title application available there. Bring valid photo ID and payment for the duplicate title fee. Check with your specific county tag office for the current fee and any additional requirements.

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PRINTABLE CHECKLIST

Required checklist

- ☐ **Government-issued photo ID** **REQUIRED**
Required to verify your identity.
- ☐ **Payment for application fee** **REQUIRED**
Check the official state DMV for the current fee amount.
- ☐ **Title replacement application (available at county tag office)** **REQUIRED**
Complete the appropriate form to apply for a duplicate title. The county tag office will provide the form.
- ☐ **Current vehicle registration (if available)** **CONDITIONAL**

FEES

Duplicate title fee (Check with your county tag office for the current duplicate title fee.)

STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

- 1 Download or obtain the state's duplicate title application form.
- 2 Complete the form with your vehicle's VIN, year, make, model, and your owner information.
- 3 Gather required ID and any supporting documents.
- 4 Submit the form and pay the duplicate title fee at a state DMV office or by mail.
- 5 Receive your duplicate title in the mail (timing varies by state).

COMMON MISTAKES

- Going to the wrong office — Georgia duplicate titles are processed at the county tag office, not a centralized state DMV.
- Not verifying the current fee with your county tag office before your visit — fees can vary.
- Forgetting that an active lienholder must generally be addressed before a duplicate title can be issued in your name alone.
